

## Town of Freeman

The regular meeting of January 28, 2019 was called to order at 7:00 pm by John Leirimo.

All members present, John Leirimo, Andy Novak, and Al Thompson.

John suggested amending the agenda to add Scenic Rivers request to access roads when road bands are on, Ocooch Mountain Rescue Donation, and Resolution in support of Telecommuting Opportunities and Telecommuter forward Certification. Andy made motion and Al seconded to include the items in the agenda.

Patrolmen hours were reviewed. Andy made a motion to approve, Al seconded. All yes.

Peggy certified the meeting was posted in the NEIA newspaper, River Bank, P.O., and the Town Shop.

Peggy presented the minutes from the 12/17/18 meeting. Approved as read.

The January bills were reviewed. John made a motion to approve, Al seconded. All yes.

### Old Business:

- FEMA: Peggy stated she is working on 2016 documentation and working with Darren Jensen from FEMA on the 2018 documentation.
- Resolution for Village of De Soto to annex parcel #008-1241-0001: Nothing to report
- TRIP: Peggy stated the township received the \$20,000.00 from the TRIP project.

### New Business:

- Discussion on selling sand to residents of the township. John made a motion to charge \$8.00 yard. Andy seconded, Al abstained. Motion carried. The decision was also made that going forward the township will no longer sell sand to residents.
- Peggy read the campaign resolution. After some discussion on the resolution, John made a motion to approve, Al seconded. Roll call vote – John – Yes, Al – Yes, Andy – No. Resolution passed.
- John presented the request from Scenic Rivers to access township when road bands on are on. Request was granted and signed. John will contact Scenic Rivers for more information on how any damage to roads will be handled.
- The request from Ocooch Mountain Rescue for the annual donation was presented, after some discussion it was suggested to send \$3,000.00. John made a motion, Al seconded. All yes.
- The Resolution in support of Telecommuting Opportunities and Telecommuter forward Certification was presented. Andy made a motion to approve, Al seconded. All yes.
- Al stated he received the information from Simpson Tractor on the mower for the township, the price is \$18,295. Al will meet with George Kinney from Simpson Tractor to discuss trading in the Township's tractor for the mower.

### Public Discussion:

- Deb Shepherd asked if the township would plow driveways for some residents that are not able to get them plowed.
