New Business:

- Discussion on setting wages for town officers when employed by township as patrolman or running errands. The decision was made to pay a town officer that is temporarily employed as a patrolman \$18.50 and hour, and if town officer is running errands they will be paid \$12.00 plus mileage. Andy made the motion, John seconded – roll call vote – all yes. The decision was also made to increase Maynard Sandy's wages to \$18.50 per hour. Al made the motion, Andy seconded. All yes.
- Discussion on getting a signed waiver from loggers to pay for any damage done to town roads while logging.
