The regular meeting of June 24, 2019 was called to order at 7:00 pm by John Leirimo.

Patrolmen hours were reviewed, Al made a motion to approve, David seconded. All yes.

Old Business:

- FEMA: Peggy stated after the WEM received the written request for the payment, the township received a payment of \$290,939.40 for 2016 damage for PW 238. This payment represents the federal portion of the 80% completion of the project. Peggy stated there are 5 sites that are not complete that make up the remaining 20% of the project. Those sites include sealcoat on Bishop Road, Rush Creek Road, Coulee Creek, Sugar Creek, and Rutter Hill Road. After the payment was received, the funds were applied to existing loans. Loan #50119064 in the amount \$116,635.56 was paid off and \$175,000.00 was applied to loan #50117126.

New Business:

- Planning and Zoning Committee Member appointments were tabled until more information could be gathered.
- Building permits were presented from Mike Taylor (2) and Andy Novak. Permits were approved.

Public Discussion:

- Paul Sampson stated a certified site map (CSM) will be needed for resident to put up a garage, the resident currently has 2 lots.
- Discussion on mowing and gravel.
- The county clean sweep will be Friday, October 25 from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm.
